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## APPLICATION FOR THE CHAPMAN FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP CHAPMAN FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

- 1. Scholarship awarded on academic performance and financial need.
- 2. All applicants will be considered regardless of sex or religion.
- 3. Applicant must be a US minority citizen and a graduating high school Senior.
- 4. Applicant must have been accepted to a school of higher learning. Specifically, a College, University, or Technical Institute. Applicant needs to attach copy of acceptance letter.
- 5. Applicant must have maintained an overall 2.8 Grade Point Average or above during high school career.
- 6. Applicant needs to attach an Official High School Transcript.
- 7. Applicant must send two letters of recommendation (One of these letters must be from a teacher)
- 8. Applications must be postmarked no later than April 7,2017. Final decisions will be made no later than April 21, 2017.
- 9. The Scholarship will be awarded by semester—50% at the beginning of the first semester and 50% at the beginning of the second semester. Recipient must send proof for both semester enrollments to Chapman Foundation P.O. Box 6533 Greenville, SC. 29607, in order to receive second semester monies. Monies will go directly to the school attending. Should the recipient fail to return to school the second semester for any reason, the second semester monies will be forfeited.
